Re: Federal Court Proceedings V No 3075 of 2001

We refer to the voicemail message left for you by Simone Bingham of this office on Thursday, 17 January 2002.

As you will recall, the Trustees of the Ansett Superannuation Plan advised His Honour Justice Goldberg in the Federal Court late last year that it was their intention to issue proceedings in the Supreme Court.

To date, we are yet to receive copies of any such proceedings and ask that you advise us:

1. Whether such proceedings have been issued and, if so, please provide copies of these proceedings as a matter of some urgency;
2. If proceedings have not been issued, please advise us if and when it is your client's intention to issue the proceedings. We ask that any proceedings, once they are issued, be provided to us; and
3. That you advise us if your clients have had a "change of mind" with respect to the institution of the Supreme Court proceedings.

Naturally, we would appreciate these advices well prior to the Directions Hearing before His Honour Justice Goldberg on 8 February 2002.
